Question 1:

Relative to item 1.1 – Bid Specifies "Connectivity: "6 x USB 3.0" Will GSA accept External USB: 4 x USB 3.1 Gen (2 front/2 rear) and 2 x USB 2.0 (2 rear)?

Response:

Yes, Connectivity: 1 x Display Port, 1 x HDMI, 1 x VGA 6 External USB Range of 3.0 to 4.0 Gen (2 front/2 rear) and 2 x USB Range of 2.0 to 4.0 (2 rear).
