Question 1:

Would like to request a pre-bid conference, please advise if a pre-bid conference can be scheduled.

Response: The Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit will be scheduled at a later date and will be sent to all prospective bidders.

Question 2:

Please confirm if vendor can terminate a 1G LC single mode or 10G single mode to the Governments switch.

Response: Yes, vendor will connect to GovGuam Switch

Question 3:

Referencing revised pricing work sheet 10/03/18, please clarify the qty/UOM for 1.1 should this remain 04 EA or should this be 01 EA.

Response: Yes, Qty 4 each at this time

Question 4:

Should the revised pricing worksheet 10/03/18 1.1 qty remain 04, please clarify if these 04 items are the 4 new locations identified as the answer to Pacific Data System's question #3 to include Department of Public Works, Department of Agriculture, Department of Corrections, Guam Office of Veteran's Affairs.

Response: Yes

Question 5:

Should the revised pricing worksheet 10/03/18 1.1 qty remain 04, we request GSA modify the bid form to indicate that the 1.1 installation charge per site and 2.1 Installation cost per site be placed under a line item, One-time charge or Non-Recurring Charge. The current field is to be placed under Monthly cost.

Response: Refer to “Amendment #4”

Question 6:

Regarding the 30 day delivery requirement, please clarify that extensions will be granted due to deployments that can be affected by typhoon’s and earthquakes and other related issues considered to be acts of God.

Response: If act of God extension will be considered.

Question 7:

Please clarify if the 30 day delivery requirement, is based on 30 business day’s not to include weekends and/or Government Holidays.

Response: Calendar days

Question 8:

Based on GSA’s response to questions received by PDS on October 4, 2019, question number 10, please advise when the requested site visit will be scheduled.

Response: Refer to response to question 1

Question 9:

Please advise when the site assessment will be scheduled and if the site assessment will be a mandatory site assessment.

Response: Yes, Mandatory

Question 10:

Please confirm if the vendor will need to provide the Government of Guam optic switch module.

Response: Yes.

Question 11:

Please confirm if vendor can provide a compatible optic module the OOT switch.

Response: Yes, as long as it is supported

Question 12:

Please confirm if connection must be on net or will a leased connection be acceptable.

Response: A connection through a subcontractor will be acceptable as long as the service meets the specifications.

Question 13:

Since vendor must provide a switch please provide the make and mode of the customers multi-mode switch.

Response: The brands of switches with fiber capability include 3COM Brocade, and Dell

Question 14:

Please confirm if the Government of Guam requires a VLAN transparency.

Response: Yes, as long as it is supported

Question 15:


