✧ **Questions Received from Guam Auto Spot, dated October 03, 2019**

Question 1: Does you have a floor plan or any layout for the buses?

Response from GRTA:

On Page 50 of 74 under *CERTIFICATIONS* of the GSA-055-19 Invitation for Bid of 14 Passenger ADA-Complaint Buses. Documentation and Certifications for this section shall be submitted with the bid, along with various submittal forms as part of Attachment "A". Detailed Floor Plan with legroom spacing in inches between seats, Front, Rear and Side Elevation Plan with Bid.

Question 1: Bus Testing Certification – What test? Altoona is a test that will be provided

Response from GRTA:

On pages 68 of 74 of the procurement documents is the "Bus Testing Certification" that needs to be completed and notarized by the vehicle manufacturer. Please refer to the attachment.

Question 2: Compliance and Non-Compliance – In regards to Buy America?

Response from GRTA:

Two certifications should be submitted, please refer to Pages 69 - 70:

a). *Pre-Award Certification for procurement of rolling stock (vendor)* comprises of certification of Compliance with Buy America and FMVSS Rolling Stock Requirement or certification of Non-Compliance with Buy America and FMVSS Rolling Stock Requirement. The transit vehicle manufacturer should select only one in order to be considered a qualified manufacturer, the manufacturer should select compliance and not non-compliance. Please refer to Pages 69 – 70.

b). *Post Delivery Certification for Procurement of Rolling Stock (vendor)* comprises of Compliance with Buy America and FMVSS Rolling Stock Requirement or Non-Compliance with Buy America and FMVSS Rolling Stock Requirement. The transit vehicle manufacturer should select only one in order to be considered a qualified manufacturer, the manufacturer should select compliance and not non-compliance. Please refer to Pages 72-73.

Question 5: Transit Vehicle Manufacturer form required with Bid - What does this mean?

Response from GRTA:

On Page 71 of 74 is the Transit Vehicle Manufacturer (TYVM) Certification to be completed by the vehicle manufacturer. Please refer to the attached Transit Vehicle Manufacturer (TVM) Certification including FTA TVMs overview and listing of eligible TVMs.
