BIDDING ON / REMARKS

Genetic Parentage Testing Services

Perform sample collections and defined tests in order to determine genetic parentage. Such collections and tests shall be performed by personnel trained and certified to perform these tasks.

Provide on-site services for blood and/or tissue collection at a designated facility or at other sites as approved by CSED. Such sites may include, and not be limited to: CSED offices, hospitals, or criminal or correctional holding institutions

Provide specimen collection services during a specified set of hours of operations, which shall be no less than 9:00am to 4:00pm on weekdays.

Notify CSED, in writing, of individuals who failed to appear for a scheduled testing within 24 hours of the failure to appear.

Provide all supplies necessary for the collection, identification, preservation and preparation of specimens for genetic parentage testing.

Identify the putative parent or parents and child or children present at the collection site at the time and place of the blood and/or tissue collection by established methods including at a minimum,

1) **One (1) form of identification per the current American Association of Blood Banks required.**

2) Information about each individual that is verified by the signature of that person or his/her guardian ..

Use a method, established in writing, to maintain a reliable and detailed chain of custody, beginning with the identification of individuals providing samples, drawing of blood or collection of tissue samples, and continuing through any court hearing process in which chain of custody or result of testing is in factual dispute.

Perform a battery of tests, which meet and/or exceed the current standards of the American Association of Blood Banks guideline for DNA-based relationship testing standards, and provide CSED with a written description of the testing and laboratory procedures that will be used in determining genetic parentage

Inclusion / Exclusion of Putative Parents

1) Inclusion shall be determined by using approved genetic system markers which result in a probability of paternity of at least ninety-nine percent (99%)

2) Exclusion shall be based on performing at least two (2) approved but different independent genetic system procedures.
